WAMITAB Level 1 Certificate in Cleaning & Support Services (OCF 501/2146/7)

Qualification summary

This qualification is designed for new entrants to the cleaning industry, and experienced workers seeking a formal qualification. The qualification provides core knowledge and understanding relevant to the requirements of the industry. Candidates who complete this qualification will acquire the skills to enable them to work safely and effectively whilst providing cleaning and support services.

Candidates will be able to progress from this qualification to the WAMITAB Level 2 Certificate in Cleaning and Support Services. This qualification will also enable candidates to widen and extend their job roles, or retrain to move into the cleaning sector.

In order to achieve this qualification, candidates must achieve a total of 18 credits.

This should be made up of: 5 credits from Mandatory Group A, a minimum of 4 credits from Optional Group B, and a minimum of 2 credits from Optional Group C. Candidates must then achieve a minimum of 4 credits from Optional Group D. The remaining 3 credits can be chosen from units in either Optional Group D or Optional Group E. However, candidates must be aware that Optional Group E comprises of Level 2 units, and therefore a maximum of 3 credits can be chosen from this group - any other credits above 3 will not count towards this qualification but can be used as credit elsewhere.

If candidates choose the Level 2 units 'Follow rules to deliver customer service' from Optional Group B, they will not be able to choose any Level 2 units from Optional Group E.

A - Mandatory Group - Candidates must complete all units in this group to achieve a total of 5 credits

Credit Value required: Minimum 5, Maximum 5.

Sub-components required: Minimum 2, Maximum 2.
