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### WAMITAB Level 2 Diploma for Sustainable Waste Management Operative (Weighbridge Operative) (QCF 501/1477/3)

#### Qualification summary

Achievement of the qualification demonstrates competence by the learner to operate appropriately and in accordance with employment requirements as a weighbridge operative (weighbridge clerk) as determined by the units selected.

The qualification is assessed 'on-the-job' at a suitable facility with weighbridge functions. Weighbridge Operatives often have responsibilities for traffic control and procedures to monitor/accept waste onto and off the site.

This may include communicating with members of the public and other persons. The structure of the qualification includes some Units which are specified in other similar WAMITAB waste management qualifications. This provides an ideal progression opportunity for learners to achieve further qualifications or specific units to match future employment requirements by building on the units and credits achieved in this qualification.

The qualification provides progression opportunities by utilising units that are common to other waste management QCF qualifications. Furthermore, earlier qualification of a similar type can, through for example, recognition of prior learning (RPL), enable progression to the learner to achieve this or other qualifications appropriate to their employment.

To achieve this qualification learners must complete 10 units (Minimum credit value - 46) - all 7 units in Group A (the mandatory group - consisting of 39 credits), plus any three units from Group B (the optional group) and in doing so ensuring achievement of at least a further 7 credits).

**A - Mandatory Group** - *Learners must complete all of the units in this group.*

*Credit Value required: Minimum 39.*

*Sub-components required: Minimum 7.*
