How are the results calculated?

To achieve a pass candidates must achieve 65% overall, comprising at least 50% on the Generic Knowledge Test (GKT) and 50% of each Activity Specific Test (AST).

If a candidate takes the GKT and one AST, they need to achieve at least 9 for the GKT and 4 for the AST plus a further 4 marks that can be gained across both tests.

If a candidate takes two or more ASTs – the score for each of these is calculated separately, added to the GKT score and must fit the same pattern, ie, at least 50% score on each test. The scores are not aggregated across the ASTs but are always worked out separately in combination with the GKT. So, for each AST the candidate should achieve 4 plus 9 for the GKT (ie, 50%) and then a further 4 to achieve 65% overall.

A worked example: Candidate takes the GKT and two ASTs:

Activity Specific Test, eg, Metal Recycling Sites 5 out of 8

Activity Specific Test, eg, End of Life Vehicles 3 out of 8

This generates a **Pass** for Metal Recycling Sites but a **Fail** for End of Life Vehicles as the candidate scored less than 50% on their specialism. The candidate will receive a Certificate for Metal Recycling Sites. However, they will need to arrange to retake the Continuing Competence Test for the End of Life Vehicles alongside a repeat of the Generic Knowledge Test.
