Introduction

Maintaining units and qualifications is critical to their ongoing success – WAMITAB must ensure that they remain:

- Fit for purpose
- Responsive to employer needs
- Accessible
- Valid, Authentic, Reliable, Current, Sufficient
- Compliant with regulatory requirements



How do we review?

- **Learner feedback** – are learners happy with the content and delivery methods?
- **National Occupational Standards** – are they latest versions?
- **Technical Advisory Groups** – are industry standards met? Are new technologies incorporated?
- **Design specifications** – is the language clear? Is there avoidable repetition? Is the unit stand alone?
- **Demand** – does registration and certification statistical data suggest ongoing demand? Do Centres expect increases in demand over time?



Impact on Centres

- **Changes to qualifications**

- It may be necessary to replace units, remove units and make minor changes to the structure of our qualifications
- We will inform Centres via email
- Changes will affect all learners that register after the implementation date of the change
- The latest version of the handbooks will be available on the website



Impact on Centres

- **Withdrawal of Qualifications**

- Qualifications may need to be withdrawn; meaning no more learners will be able to be registered after the withdrawal date
- We will inform Centres, and aim to do so at least 4 months in advance of the last registration date
- If there is demand, we may **REPLACE** certain qualifications which are withdrawn with similar provision



What does this mean for Assessment?

The assessor checklist:

- Is the qualification still live?
- Has the learner been registered with WAMITAB?
- Am I using the latest version of the qualification handbook?
- Am I familiar with any changes that may have been made?
