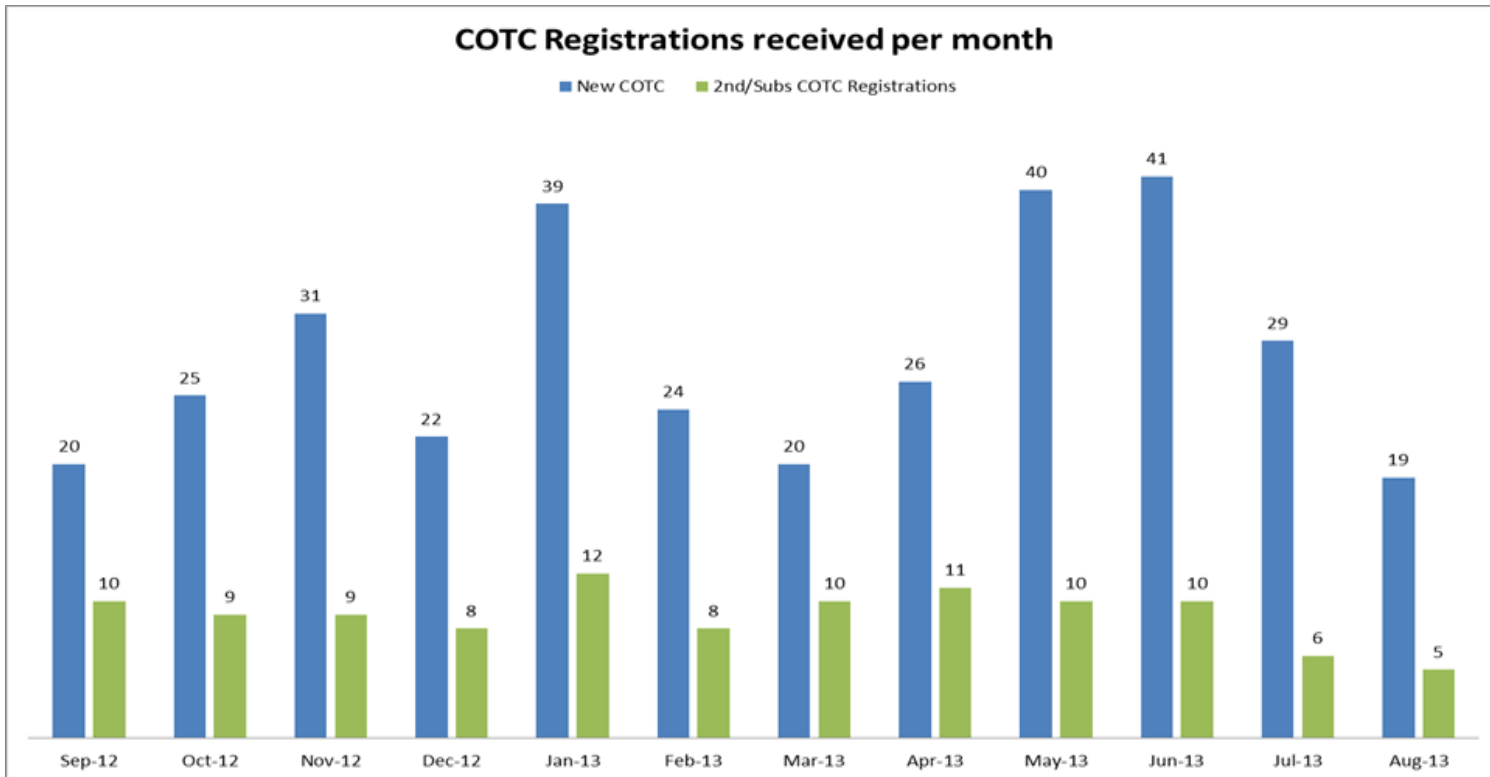

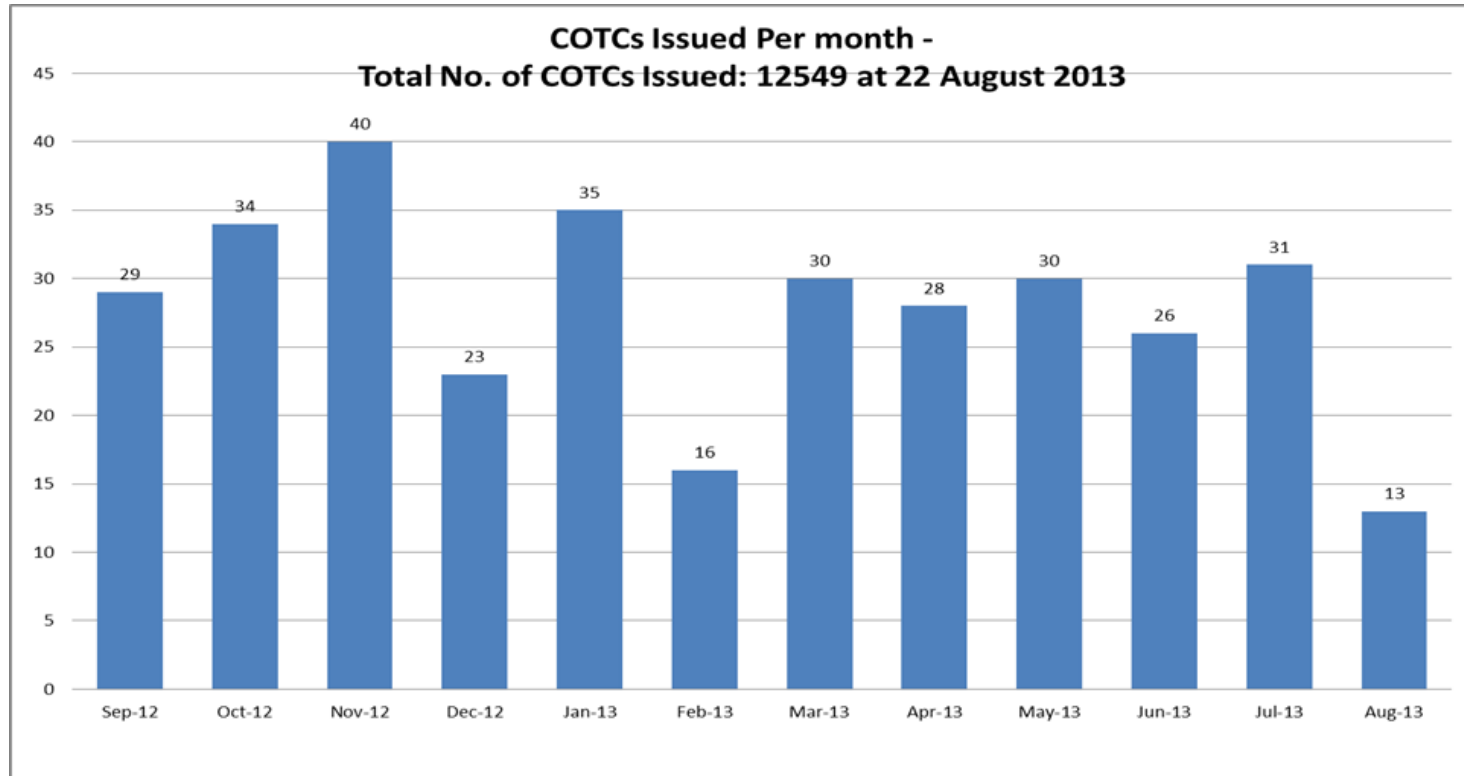

COTC'S ISSUED PER MONTH

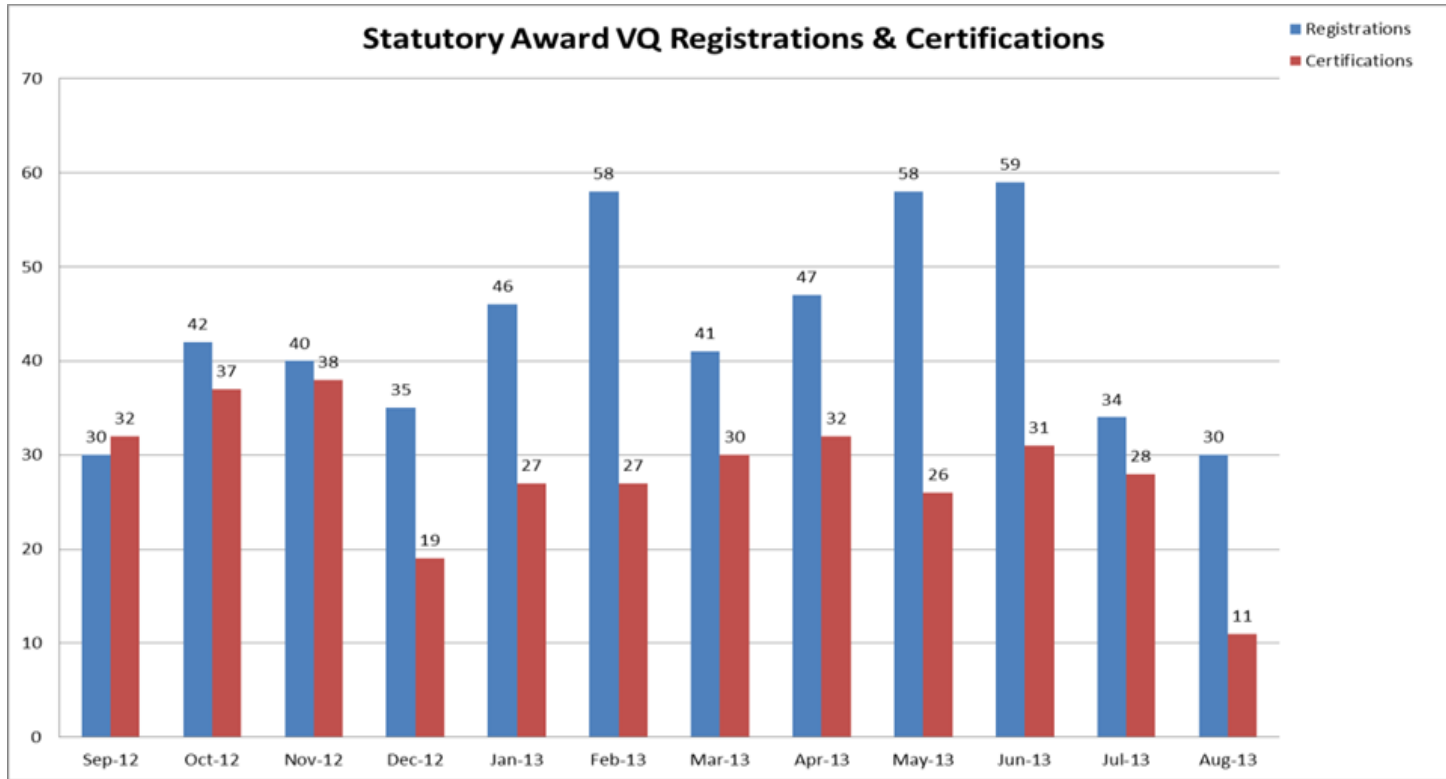

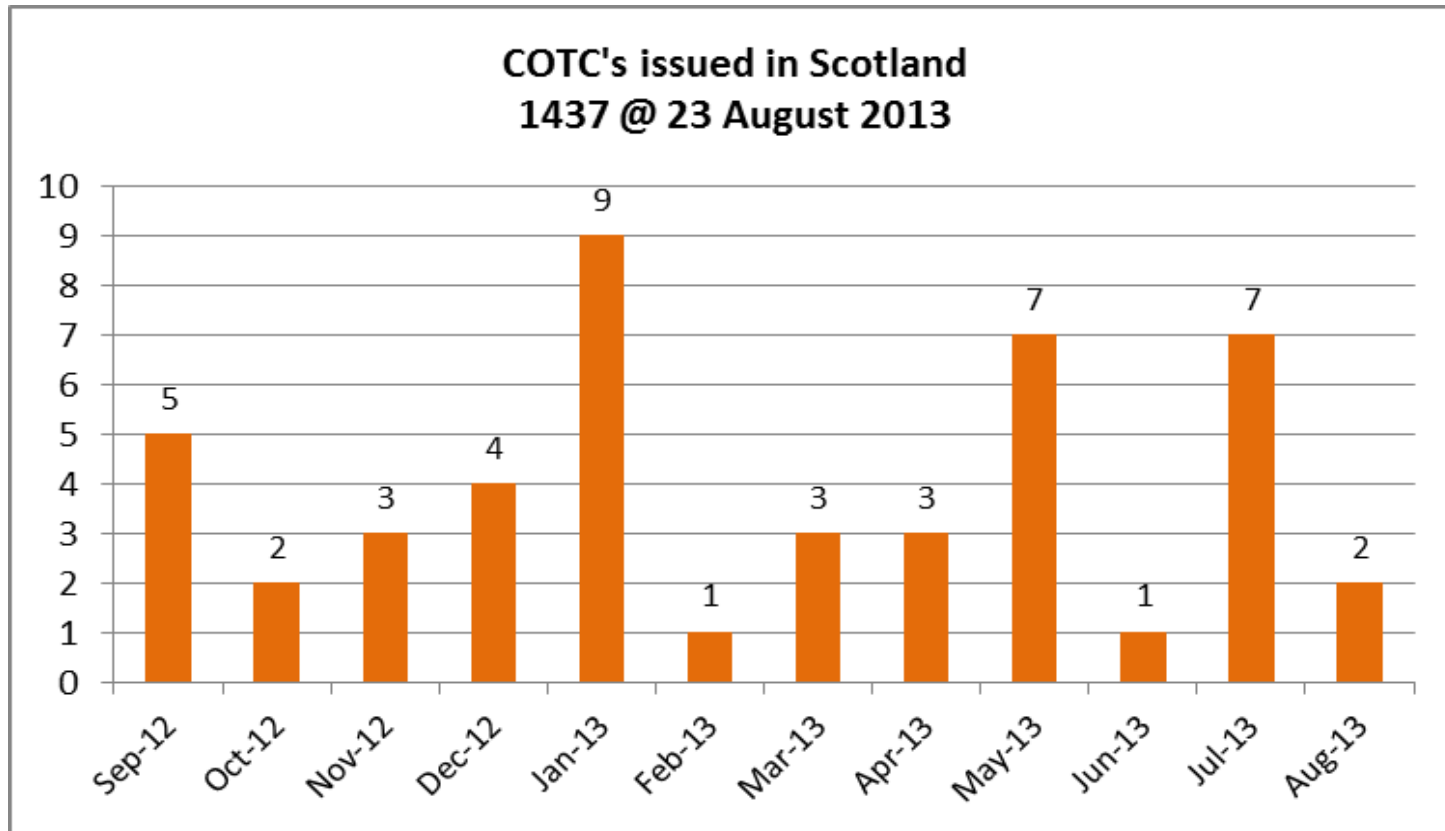

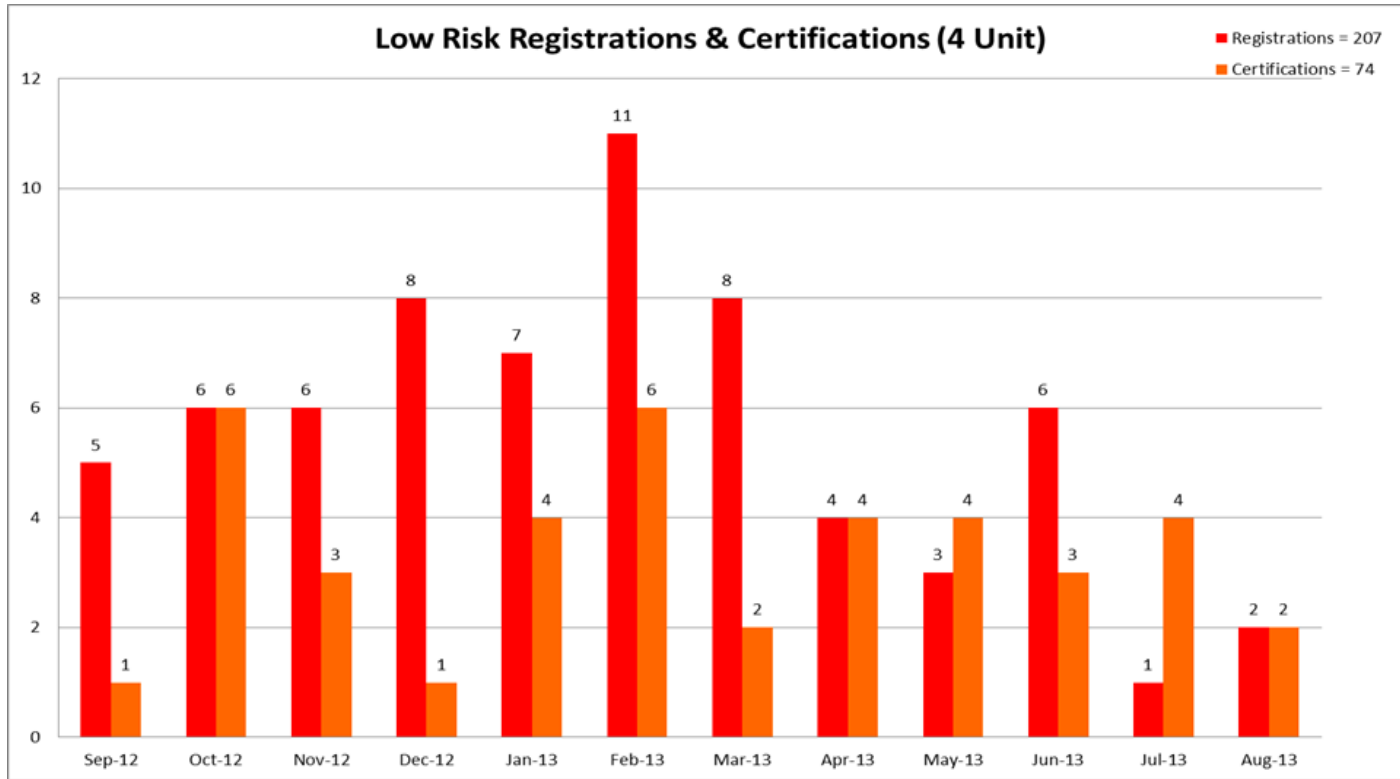

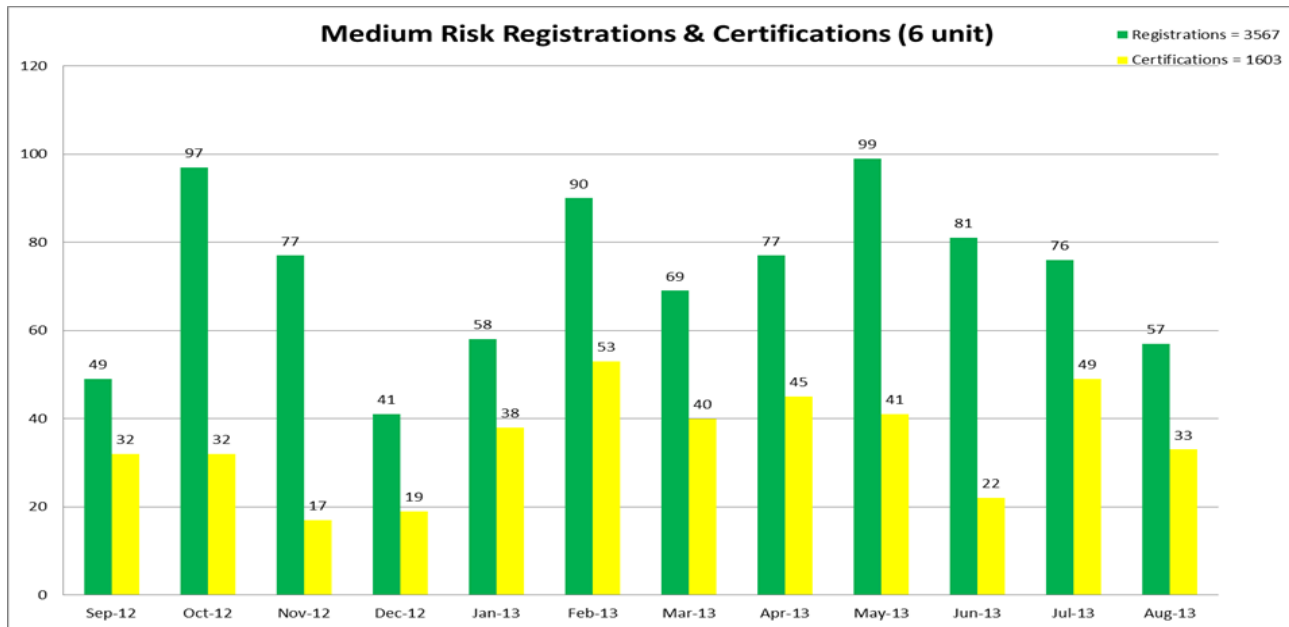
MEDIUM RISK – 6 UNIT REGISTRATIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS

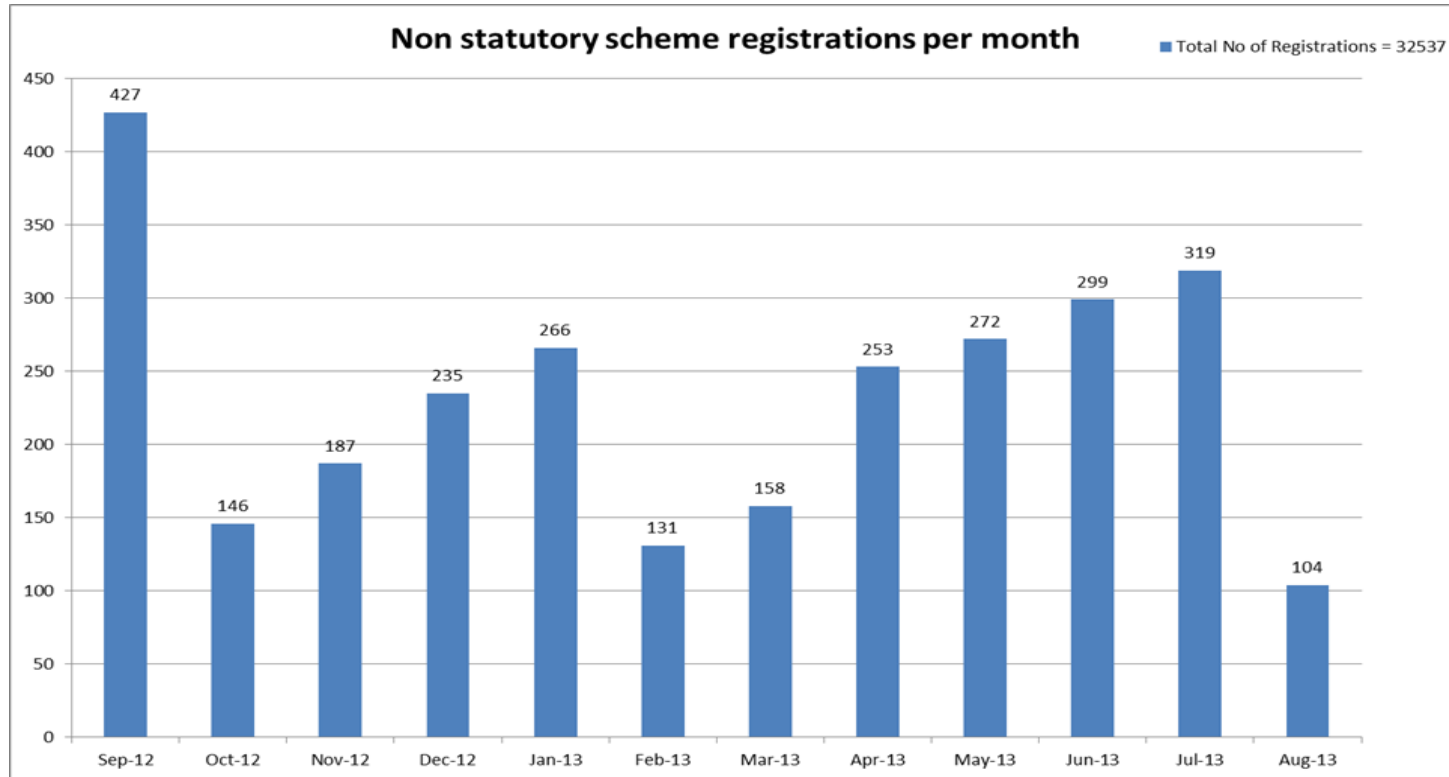

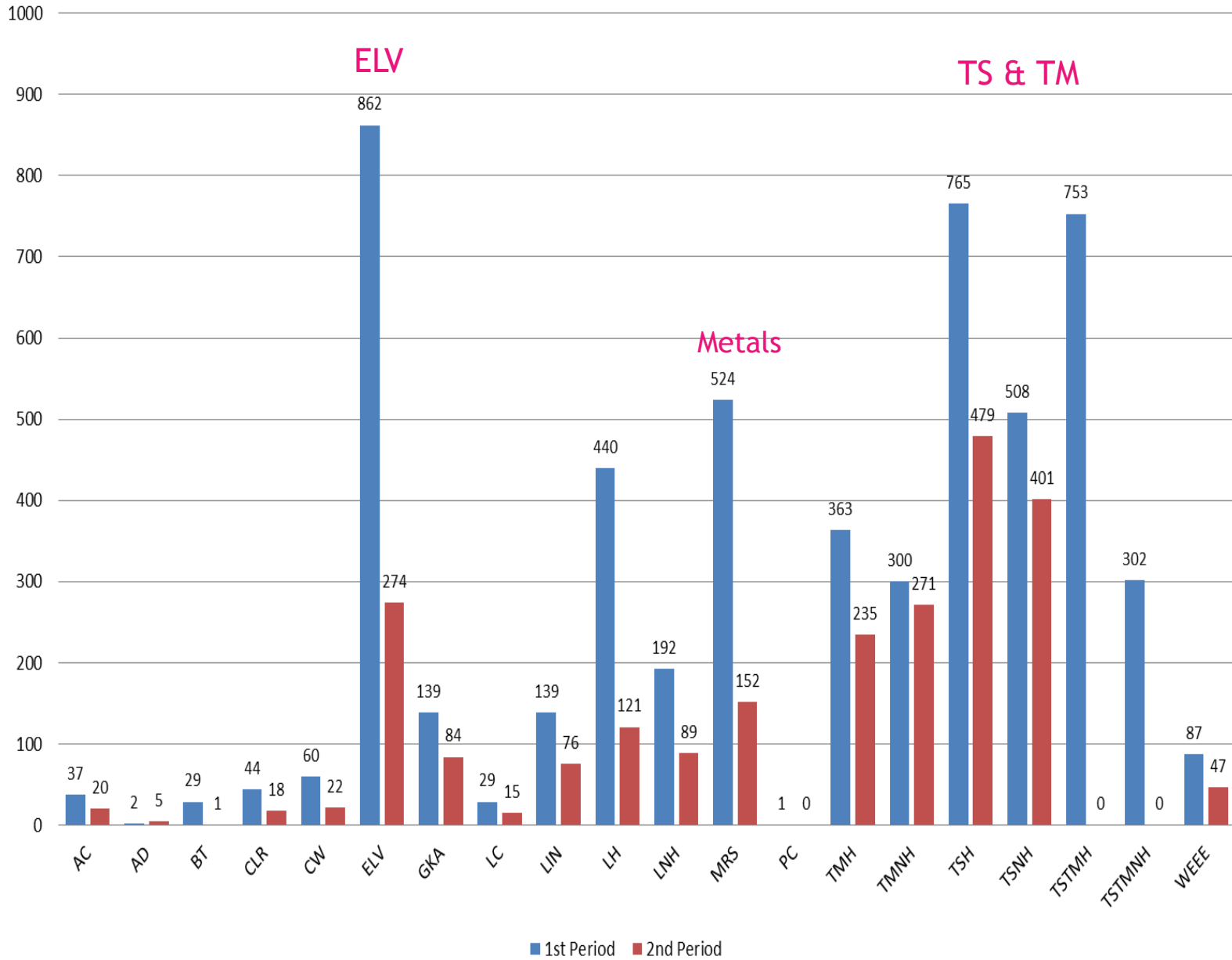

WAYS OF DEMONSTRATING TECHNICAL COMPETENCE: SCOTLAND

- Hold an appropriate CoTC
- Operator to agree with SEPA appropriate competence requirements
- **Anaerobic Digestion – 6 Unit cluster**



WAYS OF DEMONSTRATING COMPETENCE NORTHERN IRELAND

- COTC in accordance with Waste Management Licensing Regulations (Northern Ireland) (2003) (as amended)
- COTCs specified in legislation



WAYS OF DEMONSTRATING TECHNICAL COMPETENCE: ENGLAND AND WALES

Technical Competence requirements :

- Compliance with an 'Approved Industry Scheme'
 - (currently 2 schemes)
 - WAMITAB/CIWM
 - ESA/EUskills
- Hold an appropriate CoTC/12 unit Qualification/4/6-units

Historic:

- *Holding registered and validated Deemed Competence status
- *Previously been assessed as competent by the Agency
- *(includes 'Previously Exempt' activities)
- * *Continuing Competence* determines on-going status
- **In all cases are required to maintain their competence**

ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

○ CIWM/ WAMITAB

- Provide qualifications/ courses/ assessments
- Advise operators on scheme requirements
- Advise operators on choices of qualifications
- Provide data to Environment Agency

○ Environment Agency (and Natural Resources Wales)

- Understand what permit type is applied for / operated and apply Risk Tier table
- Know who are 'Deemed Competent' and who has been 'EA assessed' or 'Previously Exempt'
- Enforce Technical Competence and Continuing Competence requirements



WAMITAB ADMINISTRATION

- Assessor (and Verifier) Registrations with WAMITAB – ensure approved for appropriate qualifications (not 4 or 6 unit clusters)
- Scheme Approval requests to tie in with AVR1 requests
- ***Assessors must be registered with WAMITAB before the Qualification Authorisation is submitted!***
