



## WAMITAB Level 2 Certificate for Sustainable Waste Management Operative (Waste Collection Driver)

### About this qualification

This qualification is ideal for new entrants to the industry or experienced workers that want recognition that they possess the competence required to work as a waste or recyclables collection driver within the waste and resource management industry. This qualification supports direct entry to the waste and resource management industry for a range of job roles.

### Who is it for?

- New entrants to the industry
- Apprentices
- Experienced workers that want evidence of their skills

### What does this qualification cover?

To achieve this qualification, learners must complete 10 units in total to achieve a minimum of 33 credits. Learners must complete all mandatory units designed to improve team working skills, develop knowledge of health, safety and emergency procedures, and develop the skills to work productively and effectively transport waste.

Learners must then choose any 3 units from the optional groups to achieve a minimum of 6 credits. These optional units ensure that learners have the knowledge and skills to accept, validate, handle and load different types of waste.

Learners who choose an optional unit from Optional Group B must ensure they comply with the restrictions (if learners choose this Option Units Group B they can take a maximum of one unit – please note that learners do not have to complete units from this group) set for the group.





## What are the entry requirements of this qualification?

This qualification is open entry. This means that learners interested in undertaking the WAMITAB Level 2 Certificate for Sustainable Waste Management Operatives (Waste Collection Driver) do not require any other qualifications or levels of attainment.

## What job role could this qualification lead to or support?

This qualification is ideal for people seeking entry to the waste and resource management sector, or those who are already working and require evidence of their competence. It is a flexible qualification that can be tailored to meet the requirements of specific job roles in the sector or within a particular organisation – these job roles include:

- Waste collection driver
- Recyclables collection driver

Employers within the sector include local authorities, waste management companies or third sector (not for profit) organisations. This qualification will support the sector to overcome significant skills gaps as 30% of the waste and resource management workforce performs some form of driving task (Energy & Utility Skills, 2011) within their machine operative occupation due to the significant proportion of the workforce involved in the collection of waste materials (UKCES, 2012).
